FULL REFUND LESS APPLICATION FEE will be given if Canadian Immigration does not approve a student study permit.

**1/2 REFUND** will be given if the student withdraws prior to the starting date indicated on the Letter of Acceptance. All requests for refunds must be made in writing.

**NO REFUND** will be granted to a student after the starting date indicated on the Letter of Acceptance. This includes students who are dismissed from the program due to a breach of the law, policy or regulation as determined by the Government of Canada, the police, School District No. 43 (Coquitlam), and/or the International Education Program.
