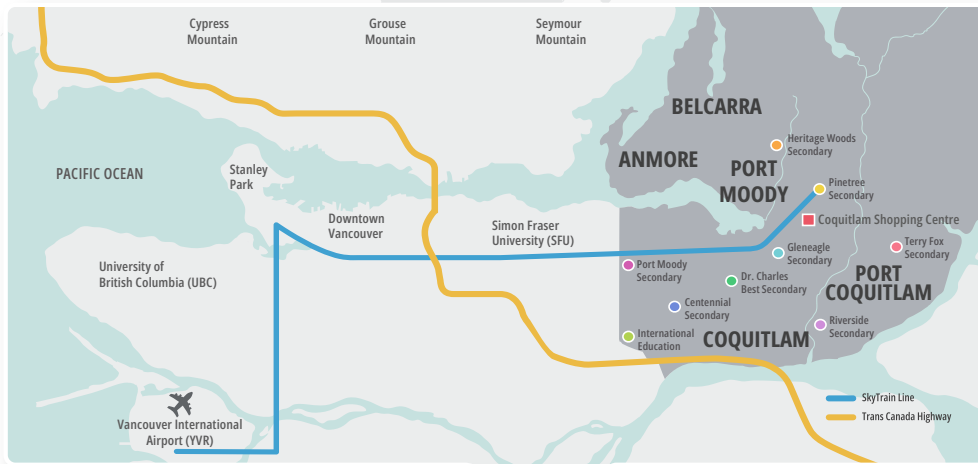

## CENTENNIAL SECONDARY

The school features trades shops, a theatre, and strong programs in music, fashion, culinary arts, and digital media. Students can take Advanced Placement courses, explore hands-on tech and design electives, or join academies in Environmental Studies and Hockey. Centennial also has its own all-weather sports field and is next to the Poirier Sport and Leisure Complex, with ice rinks, a fitness centre, and aquatic facilities. Centennial is a leader in academic, artistic, and athletic achievement.

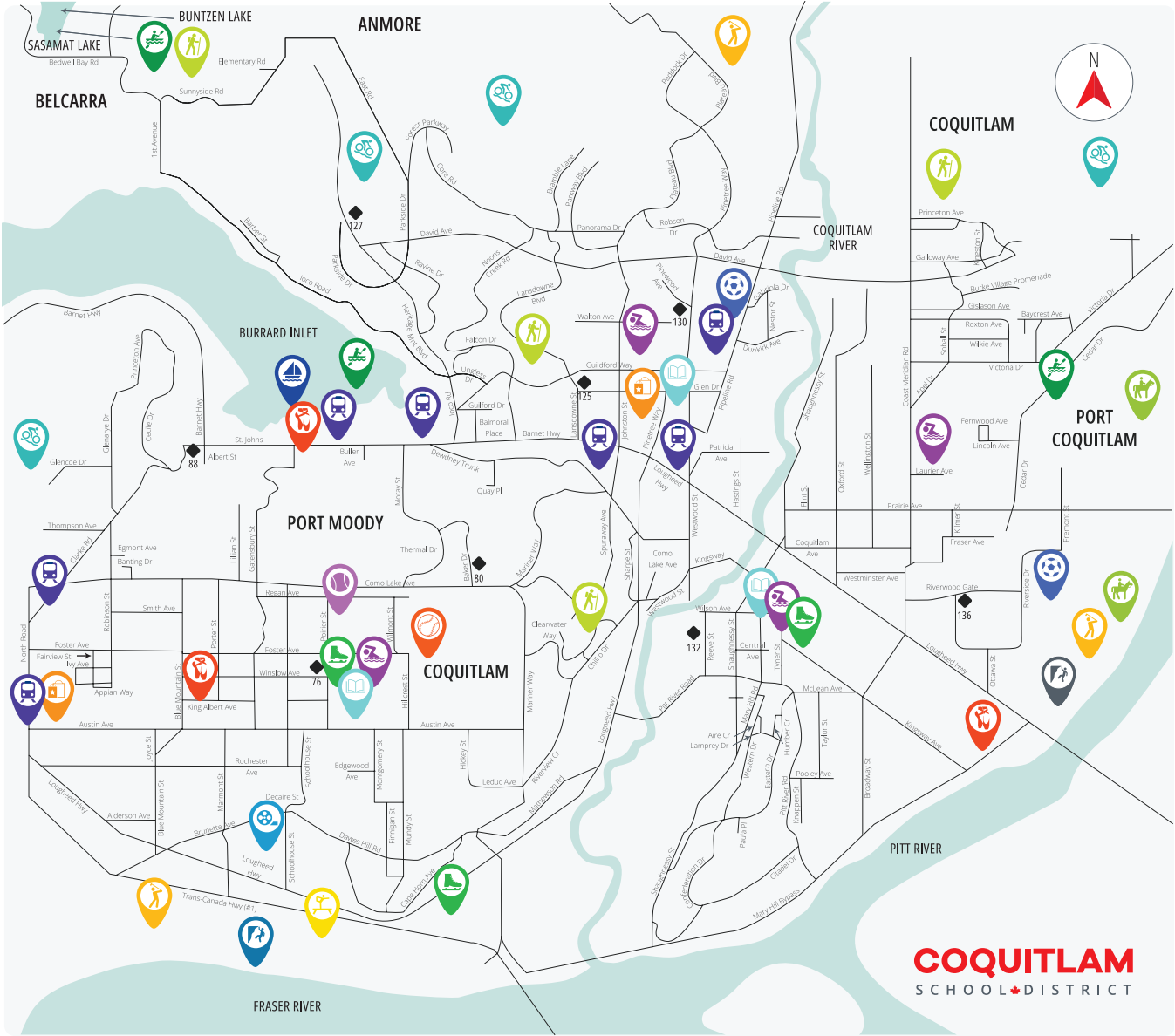

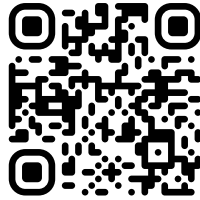
